Gary Clarke says: "To create a wash of tone and texture, several layers of tulle will lay on a base of Japanese organza. The first layer is then overlaid with a second layer of organza, to which the final stitches are applied. Using similar technique as watercolor, this technique gives a light, transparent appearance. The two layers of organza give the impression that the embroidery is worked on a translucent water-wave taffeta."

Technique: Surface Embroidery on Organza
